where we will be split into two groups for the morning tours here.

The National Dahlia Collection moved from the outskirts of Penzance to this new site at Kehelland Horticultural Centre in 2021 under the management of Louise Danks who was Production Manager at the previous location.

This colourful collection combines in excess of 1700 different cultivars and more than 20 species dahlias – a highly productive and fashionable flower in current times! Enjoy a tour, a posy-making workshop and top tips for summer dahlia care, seed collection, sowing and maintenance.

The Kehelland Horticultural Centre was established in 1982 to provide a rural horticultural setting for the support of young people and adults with learning or physical disabilities.

There will be a tour of the 16-acre site where a variety of crops, including tomatoes, chillies and apples are grown. An extensive plant nursery produces seasonal bedding, herbs, herbaceous perennials, native flowers, shrubs and trees that are beneficial to wildlife. Kehelland also specialises in producing its own Cornish variety apple juices.

1pm/1.30pm: Cornhill Farm, Higher Kehelland, Camborne TR14 0DH

At lunchtime, we then have the opportunity to visit the award-winning Cornhill Farm, which is approximately one mile away. Here, we will look at the wildflower mixes that are grown in the fields where their 14,000 chickens free range and there will be a short talk on soil fertility. You can either bring a picnic or pre-order pasties for lunch, which can be enjoyed in the fields or down by the ponds.

Directions: Come off the A30 at the Camborne West junction and follow the directions to Connor Downs and Trevaskis Farm on the old A30, heading west. About half a mile after the Premier Inn Camborne, turn right and head back under the A30. Both Kehelland Trust and Cornhill Farm are signposted from this junction and are approximately one mile further from this underpass.
