10.30am: Meet at Kestle Barton, Manaccan, Helston TR12 6HU.

This ancient farmstead and gallery is situated above Frenchman's Creek. The garden was created in the south-facing mowhay by James Alexander Sinclair and includes gauzy swathes of herbaceous plants and sweeping grasses. Beyond is a wild flower meadow and adjacent orchard.

Dogs on leads. Good wheelchair access.

Directions: Brown signs from B3293. DO NOT USE SAT NAV.

2.30pm: Meet at Tregonning, Carleen, Breage, Helston TR13 9QU.

Andrew and Kathryn Eaton's sculpted grass meadow, with panoramic views from Carn Brea to Helston is where we park. Part of the garden is designed in the form of a plant with leaf-shaped beds. There is a formal front garden, top garden/games lawn, a Summer House, a Spring garden, a Mediterranean patio, a carp pond and fernery, and a packed vegetable garden.

Dogs on leads. Disabled access.

Directions: From Helston B3302 go to Godolphin Cross. From crossroads in centre of Godolphin Cross, head south towards Carleen. In 1/2m at fork signed Breage, 1 1/4m turn right up no through road. After 1/2m, park on left opposite Tregonning Farm.
