Hidden Valley Gardens is an award-winning RHS partner garden. It is a colourful, 3.5-acre cottage-style garden in a secluded valley. There are many beds and borders with herbaceous perennials, shrubs and grasses. There is also a potager for vegetables and herbs with soft fruit bushes and cut flower collections. The diverse garden includes a large wildlife pond, Japanese and Mediterranean areas, and a fernery.

2.30pm Meet at Tregrehan Garden, Par PL24 2SJ.

Tucked into St Austell Bay, Tregrehan is one of the Great Gardens of Cornwall and has an enviable location for a woodland garden. Towering conifers from the early Victorian plant hunters combined with botanically important recent planting has resulted in more than 150 trees reaching champion status. This family-run garden is a delight at any time. The old grain mill, walled garden and magnificent glasshouse are also wonderful spaces to enjoy.
