There will be two groups of up to 40: one starting at Scorrier House, the other at Trevince. If you wish to be with particular people, please indicate when booking and I will try to accommodate you. When confirmations are sent out, you will be notified of your group and starting place.

10.30am: Meet at Scorrier House, Redruth TR6 5AU.

Originally built as an office in 1780 by mining tycoon, John Williams, the seventh generation of the family to occupy the house, Caroline and Richard Williams, are kindly allowing us to visit the gardens that were planted later. The great Victorian nurseryman, botanist and plant collector, William Lobb was employed here as a boy. There is a more formal herbaceous border and conservatory near the house, and a vegetable garden in the walled garden. Spring is one of the best times to visit as the bluebells, camellias and rhododendrons should be in bloom.

Dogs on leads. Partial disabled access.

Directions: Take the Scorrier exit from the A30 on the B3298. At the first roundabout, exit St Day and Scorrier is a few hundred yards on the right.

2.30pm: Meet at Trevince, Gwennap, Redruth TR16 6BA.

Newly open to the public, Richard and Trish Stone are restoring the grounds of their country house, which include a south-facing garden and parkland covering more than 25 acres. There is a one-acre walled garden, an ornamental woodland walk, an orchard and a pinetum with a collection of vulnerable and endangered conifers. Bluebells and a flowering davidia are highlights in May. Current projects include the restoration of a brick summerhouse in the Pond Garden and citrus cultivation in the glasshouses.

Dogs on leads. Partial disabled access.

Directions: Come off the exit for the A3047 (Helston) and B3298 (Scorrier). Start towards Redruth, turn left just before the Crossroad House Care Home and the Caravan and Motorhome sale room, and pass under a railway bridge. At the crossroads, go straight ahead and follow the B3298 for 3½m through Carharrack and down almost to the A393 Redruth-Falmouth road. Ten metres before that junction, turn left for Gwennap. After ¼m the road branches. Go left across the weak bridge and straight ahead through the gateway with large granite gateposts.

Lunch suggestions: Pub opposite Scorrier, The Fox and Hounds.
